Eligibility and Judging Criteria

Organizations must provide direct services in the Village of Corrales, and ideal applicants will provide a wide benefit to the Corrales community. Submissions should be focused on supporting education, the environment, empowering girls and women, and/or improving quality of life in Corrales. Intel New Mexico and Corrales MainStreet will evaluate submissions based on the project or program's:

- Positive impact on Corrales residents
- Long-term viability
- Clearly stated and measurable goals and objectives
- Overall creativity
- Timeline
- Detailed, reasonable, and appropriate budget with itemized costs identified with vendor quotes. Budgets must include an explanation for how and why items are critical to achieving a successful outcome.

Please note that all awarded organizations must use grant funding by December 31, 2024. Grantees will also be required to submit a photo of their project or organization and proof of performance (POP) following the program or project's completion, no later than December 1, 2024.

Grant amount

A total of \$8,000 is available to award grants and will be split between recipients. Awards will be allocated based in part on projects' requested funds and the strength of successful applications.
